

FAQs Angel Investing School

When will the Angel Investing School course take place? How intensive will it be?

Tentative programme schedule:

- Wednesday 6th November 4-6pm GMT
- Wednesday 13th November 4-6pm GMT
- Wednesday 20th November 4-6pm GMT
- Wednesday 27th November 4-6pm GMT

The delivery of sessions will be remote but follow a <u>similar lesson plan</u> as this example delivered in four weeks.

What can I expect from the Angel Investing School?

<u>Open Angel</u> is a great starting point for anyone eager to learn a little more before the course starts in November. Even more information on how the course is run and managed online can be found <u>here</u>.

Who is it for?

Investing in startups has historically created immense wealth for a select few who had access to the right information and tools, leaving behind a significant equity wealth gap. Our intention with the Angel Investing School is to bridge this gap by empowering members of the music community with tools and knowledge to build wealth now, and for future generations to come.

We are open to anyone from underrepresented backgrounds, who can commit to taking part in 4 x 2 hour online training courses, and who has a passion and interest in the music industry and in music technology, or music adjacent technology start-ups. We also recommend that applicants are earning around or above £100,000 in the UK, or \$200,000 for those applying in the US.

I've never made an investment before, is it right for me?

At Angel Investing School we believe that anyone can become an investor. With investments starting from as little as £1000, you don't have to be extraordinarily wealthy, just open-minded and interested in helping to build and grow a music industry that is fit for purpose.

I'm not specifically from the music industry, can I apply?

This course is for people with a passion and knowledge in music, or an interest in using their personal wealth to create a stronger music industry and ecosystem. We are interested in hearing from you whether you are currently a top music industry executive, working in music, or even working in adjacent entertainment industries, whether you are retired or starting out in your career. But a passion for music would help.

Eligibility Criteria

- Passionate about music and the music industry
- Interested in becoming an Angel Investor
- Earning £100,000 or \$200,000+
- From an underrepresented background within the music industry

Angel Investing School is a UK company, based in London. However, this programme is open to anyone in the world with an interest and passion in helping to grow the music industry, and invest your personal wealth. We are not restricting this programme to UK based participants, but anyone interested in applying from outside UK should speak to Grow Music about where you are based, so that we can programme the course around the most appropriate time zones for all participants.
